## Western Powerline Trail

This historic trail (built in 1911 by the US Bureau of Reclamation) has seen many modern improvements. Running east/west from Rural Rd. in Tempe to Power Rd. in Gilbert, the trail connects several north/south routes, building an extensive network. The Gilbert portion connects major parks, downtown Gilbert, and Gilbert's first brewery. This map highlights a suggested route from Arizona Wilderness Brewing through the Heritage District to Riparian Preserve at Water Ranch. Take on the full route or just a section. Bike safe and enjoy the trail!



## Arizona Wilderness Brewing

Gilbert's first brewery has a passion for Arizona's agricultural community and have woven Arizona wild-grown and farm-grown products into their craft beer and pub menu. They were voted "Best New Brewer in the World" in 2013 and now produce over 100 different brews each year.

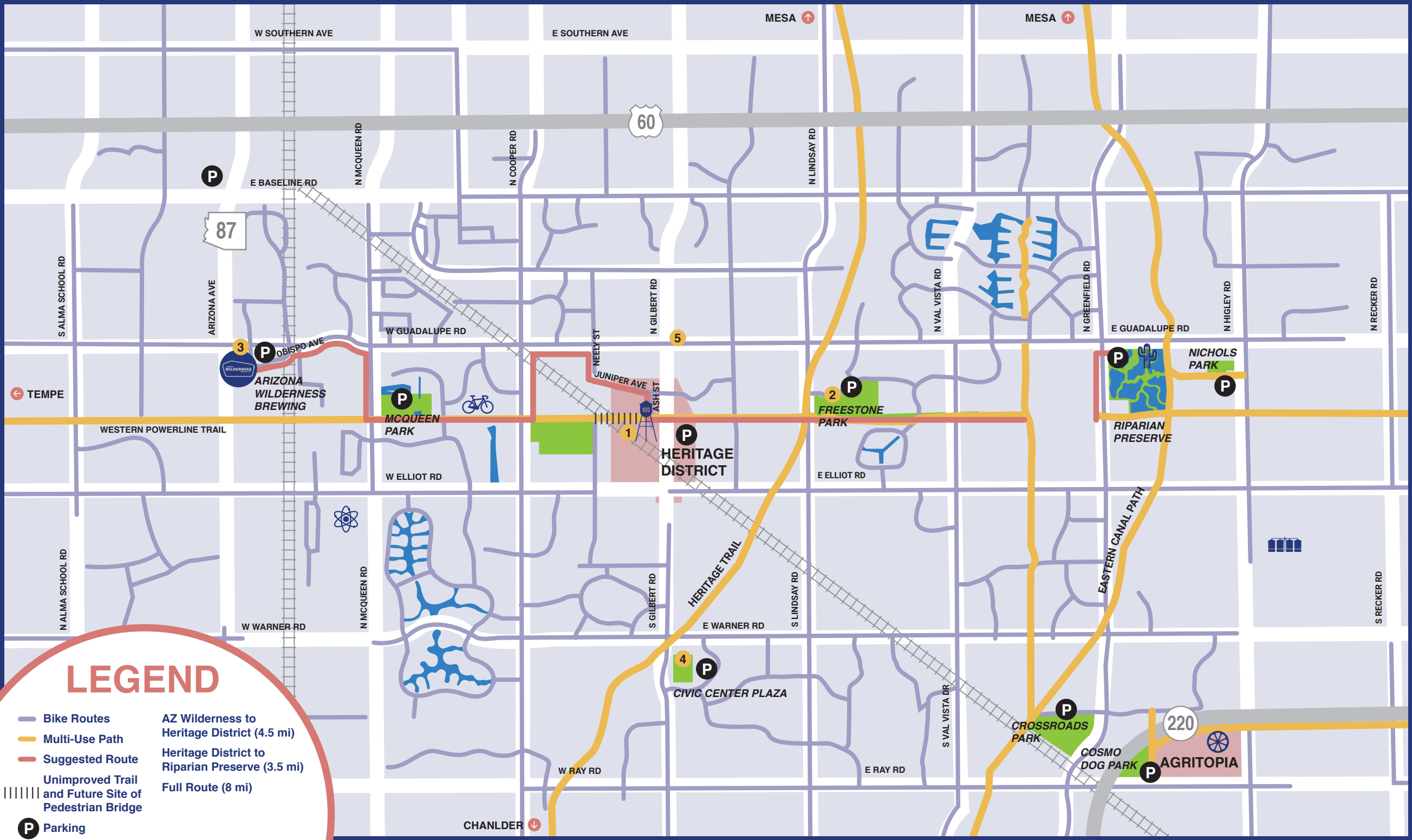

## Riparian Preserve

Created as an innovative and unique way to combine water resource development with wildlife habitat, educational, and recreational opportunities. The Riparian Preserve features an urban fishing lake and over 4.5 miles of trails alongside 7 ponds. It is identified as a National Audubon Society Important Bird Area.
