SITE & VENUE HIGHLIGHTS


Gilbert Regional Park is setting a new standard for parks and recreation both in Arizona and nationally. This regional park offers the opportunity to dedicate 272 acres to serve multiple community needs, providing recreation amenities while embodying the priorities of health, safety, and welfare. Phase 1B of Gilbert Regional Park has been completed as of October 2020, with further additions in the works. One of these projects includes Cactus Surf Park, a 25 acre development featuring a wake park, surf lagoon, sandy beach, restaurants and more. The area around Gilbert Regional Park boasts over 30 hotels in close proximity. SanTan Village, an open-air mall with national retailers, big-box stores, sit-down restaurants & fast food is within ten minutes from the park.

- An amphitheater flanked by a 7-acre lake opening to a 10-acre event lawn that can hold up to 10,000 attendees
- 16 pickleball courts
- 6 tennis courts
- 2 basketball courts
